6. YOUR CAKE WILL NOT BE RETURNED! The cakes will be used as the prizes at the Octoberama Cake Walk booth!

*You may cover your cake with plastic wrap using toothpicks to keep wrap off of cake, bake your cake in disposable pan with plastic lid, or place cake in a cardboard box covered with plastic wrap. Store bought cakes come in great containers. Extra wide plastic wrap will be available at cake drop off.
